Was Peter **Wrong**?

- ✓ No scripture indicates that what they did in choosing Matthias was wrong.
- ✓ If choosing Matthias was wrong, then Peter was guilty of misusing the OT prophecy.
- ✓ Because Paul was a genuine apostle does not argue against Matthias, or others in the NT being called apostles (Acts 14:4, 14).
- ✓ Paul had a unique ministry separate from the 12. He never argued that he was a member of the 12. In fact, he indicated just the opposite: 1 Cor. 15:5, 8.
